A Note from the Pastor

God's Plan for Disciple-making



Jesus is in the disciple-making business, and discipleship is not just for the chosen few. it's for everyone who would follow Jesus – it's for you and me too. Right after His baptism, signaling the beginning of His public ministry, Jesus gathered men and women who would "follow" Him and sit at His feet to learn. Jesus personally called 12 men to become His students, men who would sit at His feet as pupils to be taught by the one who was sent from heaven and

who spoke with divine authority. Jesus opened their minds to understand the Scriptures and how the entirety of the Old Testament pointed to His birth, life, death, and resurrection in order to give forgiveness of sins, peace with God, and eternal life for all who would believe in Him.

Those 12 disciples were the core and the beginning of all those who would follow our Lord. Right before Jesus ascended into heaven, He gave his disciples a command, "make disciples." The disciples were to make disciples, but how? And who? For how long?

Let's let our Lord answer theses questions. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have

commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matt. 28:19-20).

- 1. A disciple's faith is fixed on Jesus. Jesus's command to baptize is the first step in disciple-making. Why? Baptism points our faith from ourselves and onto Jesus. Baptism is what God does to us not what we do for God. Baptism is where God gives us a new identity as His child who now belongs to His family. Baptism delivers to us what Christ has won for us through His death and resurrection. A disciple's eye of faith is fixed on Jesus, who is the author and finisher of our faith. This disciple-making is for "all nations." God doesn't discriminate; discipleship is open to all ages, to males and females, to all people from every part of the earth. Christ died for all, so all are invited to a life of "following" Jesus.
- 2. A disciple is a learner. Baptism is the initiation of the discipleship, learning marks the life of a baptized follower of Christ. Notice how "teaching" is a continual activity. A disciple never grows out of being a "learner." This is what Peter meant when he wrote, "Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation" (1 Peter 2:2). How easy it is to fall into the thinking and practice of "I don't need to learn anymore. I've read the Bible cover to cover. I've been to enough Bible studies. I'll learn on my own. I have already studied that Bible book. I know what I believe and don't need to learn anything new."

Disciples are made, actually they are continually being made, because they are to be continually learning all that our Lord Jesus has taught. It's not so much about learning information as it is about the Holy Spirit continuing to convict us of our shortcomings and building us up in the faith delivered to us in our baptism. The Word of God is rich and active and is the source of strength and life of a disciple. How are you growing and learning? How is your life as a disciple of Jesus? Are you a "learner?" Do you have the hunger as a little child to learn all that our Lord has to teach you?

This is my prayer for myself and for you. May we humble ourselves, and sit ourselves at the feet of Jesus to learn from His Word. May we never grow bored of the Scriptures and think we have no need to learn from Him. Let's do this together. Let's learn, and study, and pray, and share this life of discipleship together, and let's keep making disciples of all nations. We don't do this alone, thank God. We have a promise from Jesus as we live as His disciples and make disciples: "and behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." So what are we waiting for?



On August 1st, we are going to watch the movie The Creation, have our last water play day, bubble day and free lunch.


The week of August 12-16 we are closed for teachers' training and classroom setting.



To Those Loved by the Father in Christ Jesus,

Our times of worship, fellowship, and study of God's Word are truly blessed times. Thanksgiving, forgiveness, and peace abound when we gather. What a juxtaposition with the age in which we live! If we spend any time observing the news, or our own community, the sense that the period of time in which the Lord has appointed for us to live is troubled cannot be denied. Indeed, one of the many troubles seems to be a

heightened divisiveness. Not long ago, within the lifetimes and memories of most of us, ideas of patriotism and the concept of the "melting pot" undergirded our society, granting a sense of unity that no longer pervades this nation. Racism, sexism, and religious persecution have once more reared their ugly heads, though our forebears dealt the apparent killing blow in events you may have heard of – the Civil War, Women's Suffrage, and the American Revolution. Now, diversity, inclusion, and social justice reign in the public square, all promising deliverance and equality, while highlighting and intensifying dividing lines.

There is some truth in what is being put out there in the name of diversity and inclusion and social justice, that human beings are always tribal, always finding groups and ideas to be a part of. And, this tribalism inevitably leads to the shedding of blood, like what we are seeing in Portland, Oregon. In fact, that kind of division and bloodshed is exactly what God has done in Jesus Christ: a people purchased through the shedding of His blood! Through the death of Christ, God made us part of His family. Listen to what God said through the Apostle Paul:

is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands— ¹² remember that <u>you were at that</u> time **separated** from Christ, **alienated** from the commonwealth of Israel and **strangers** to the covenants of promise, having **no hope** and **without God** in the world. ¹³ **But now** in **Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.** ¹⁴ For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has <u>broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility</u> ¹⁵ by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might <u>create in himself</u> one new man in place of the two, so <u>making peace</u>, ¹⁶ and might <u>reconcile us both to God in one body</u> through the <u>cross</u>, thereby <u>killing the hostility</u>. ¹⁷ And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. ¹⁸ For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. ¹⁹ So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the <u>saints and members of the household of God</u>, ²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole structure, being <u>joined together</u>, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. ²² In him you also are being <u>built together</u> into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit." – Ephesians 2:11 – 22 (we were formerly separated in our tribes and separated from God, but now have been reconciled to God and made into one people in Christ)

Rather than embrace the lie of our racial, gender, cultural, or social differences dividing us to the point of hostility, let us embrace the true peace, unity, and love for one another we have in Christ Jesus. It is in Christ that we have our identity, not in those earthly things. Praise God for that!







Instead of "Mite Boxes" some societies called their ingathering devices "blessing boxes" or "mission boxes" or "thank offering boxes." Place your Mite Boxes in visible areas so that we are reminded every day to give thanks for all His blessings.

Put your offering in the Mite Box at the end of each day.

Say "thank you" with an appropriate amount whenever calamity or misfortune has been avert-

Empty all your loose change from your kitchen coin bowl into the Mite Box weekly.

Put a dollar in the Mite Box for every pair of shoes you own.

Pay for items with bills and then empty your coins that have gathered in your wallet each day into your Mite Box.

In thanksgiving, put a dollar into the Mite Box for every family member.

Throughout the decades, Lutheran women have stepped out in faith, setting goals and trusting God to move the hearts of His people to give generously to LWML's mission of proclaiming the Gospel.

Times and Mite Boxes Change

Mite Boxes have changed in color and design over the years, but what has never changed is the dedication of freely given offerings for the purpose of reaching out to others with the Good News of Jesus Christ. Districts still retain 75% of mite offerings for the work of the LWML at that level. Based on the Biblical account of the widow's mite, the Mite Box is intended for regular contributions of "mites" — offerings above and beyond the support given to the congregation and the Synod. Mite Box contributions amount to millions of dollars that fund district and national mission grants. In fact, the LWML has collected over \$100 million dollars since 1942. Yes ... these coins have and will continue to make a difference. Thank you for contributing to the Mite Box and providing the opportunity for us to spread the Gospel to the world.




